- 1 VIP Restroom Trailer (4 units including sinks in units)
- 5 Handicap Units
- 59 Standard Chemical Toilets
- 9 Two-Station Sinks

**Additional Requirements:**

- Quote should include all necessary supplies and materials.
- All units must be serviced between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Sunday, August 2, 2009.
- Equipment is to be dropped at different locations throughout the Festival site. The expected number of drop locations is expected to be a minimum of 8, but will not exceed 10 drop locations.
- Delivery of 12 standard units and one sink station is to take place at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, July 31, 2009. All other units are to be delivered at 8:00 p.m. on Friday, July 31, 2009. All units must be picked up by 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 2, 2009.
- The festival site has gray water barrels that require servicing (emptied) twice during the festival. Once between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 2, 2009, and second between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 2, 2009. The barrels will be supplied by the festival and are located in four separate locations on festival grounds near food court areas. The total number of barrels is expected to be as follows: 12 – 55 gallon barrels, and 8 – 30 gallon barrels. The portolet vendor selected must be able to provide this service.
